

A Field Workshop – September 18, 2019 Highlighting the Companion Guide to the Field Indicators for Identifying Hydric Soils in New England, Version IV



This is an advanced workshop for soil scientists and others who are familiar with documenting soil profile descriptions under field conditions. Location: Vicinity of Bridgewater, Massachusetts

Transportation: Sites include properties secured by the State Correctional Center; consequently, participants must travel on the school bus which has been contracted for this program. Participants will not be allowed to use their personal vehicles for transportation to the field sites.

Clothing & Footgear: Must be suitable for the field and for expected weather conditions.

Equipment: Provide your own spade, auger, color chart, spray bottle, clipboard, pencils, and anything else that you typically use to prepare soil profile descriptions. **Insect repellent is encouraged**.

Lunch: A boxed lunch will offer a limited choice of sandwiches.

Water: You are encouraged to bring water; however, bottled water will be available at the assembly point.

Restrooms: There are no facilities at the field sites; however, the restrooms at the Soccer Field are expected to be open.
